JavaScript Obfuscater is a drag & drop AppleScript application that makes JavaScript extremely difficult to read. The idea is that reverse engineering the obfuscated code would take more time than writing it from scratch.

Drag & drop any number of JavaScript files & folders containing JavaScript files onto **JavaScript Obfuscater**'s icon.

JavaScript Obfuscater does not modify the original file, it creates a new file in the same location as the original. The new file has the same name with the prefix **JO_**.

JavaScript Obfuscater:

- Removes all comments.
- Changes variables and constants to random names.
- Makes every line as close to 255 characters as possible.

JavaScript Obfuscater is relatively slow since it's AppleScript and has a lot to do. Be patient...

Warning: the code does not check if a file is JavaScript.

The Legal Drivel:

JavaScript Obfuscater was saved with its AppleScript code so you can view or edit it. To do this, drag & drop **JavaScript Obfuscater** onto the **Script Editor** icon.

JavaScript Obfuscater contains code snippets from Apple Developer Connection.
